The Teddi Dance for Love is a 24-hour dance marathon coordinated by a student run committee and held on the St. John Fisher College campus. This year will be a bit different; the event will take place with a mix of in-person and virtual elements.

We aim to bring better days to some of the children and families that need it the most by funding the Teddi Project at Camp Good Days and Special Times. We dance every year to send these special kids and young adults on the trip of a lifetime. With the funds that we raise, campers have an opportunity to visit Florida for a week spending time at Walt Disney World, Universal Studios, the beach, and other fun places.

By supporting the Teddi Dance for Love and Camp Good Days with your sponsorship, you can help us make this trip even more special for those campers. Any amount that you can donate will help us tremendously. Because of people like you, the dance has prospered and we have been able to help more children. Who is Teddi?



Elizabeth "Teddi" Mervis



In 1979, Elizabeth "Teddi" Mervis was diagnosed with a malignant brain tumor at the age of nine. Her father, Gary Mervis, realized that it was not the treatment that was causing Teddi the most pain, but it was the loneliness of being the only child in her school and neighborhood dealing with cancer.

With the help and support of many friends and community members Gary founded Camp Good Days & Special Times, a not-for-profit organization. It provided Teddi and other children with cancer the opportunity to come together in a residential camping experience and to understand each other.

Gary looked towards Dr. Lou Buttino, a St. John Fisher College professor, for help to write his story of Camp Good Days. Dr. Buttino's students wanted to contribute. In 1982 a small group of students and Dr. Buttino launched the first annual Teddi Dance for Love. All the proceeds go to Camp Good Days. Since then, it has been a tradition at St. John Fisher College for 37 years, and has raised over \$1.1 million.
